Tips on Web Building

- Do not expect to have a huge site from the beginning.
- Respecting the privacy of others.
- Protect the safety of children.
- View other family web sites for ideas.
- Use online free hosting sites.
- Set up a schedule for archiving and maintaining web data.
- Read the NGS Standards and Guidelines on web publishing and sharing information.

Tips on Blogging

- Remember your audience. Try not to go of topic.
- Your first blogs should define the purpose and the technology.
- Remind everyone that this is part of the permanent public record.
- Encourage child security.
- Family blogs should be inclusive. Create blogs on the multiple branches in your family.
- Enhance readability by using space, colors, emphasis and photos.
- Create blogs ahead of time to allow time for editing, and more editing.
- Edit, Edit, Edit. Spell Check. Post, Edit, Edit. Post. Edit. Post. (Ok. One post complete.)
- Create an archiving system.
